Reflection

"He presented himself alive to them by many proofs after he had suffered, appearing to them during forty days and speaking about the kingdom of God." Luke spends a great deal of time on Jesus's words about the kingdom of God. The kingdom of God is what Christians are charged to make manifest in the world, right now. It is when we are following Jesus's words and living with the guidance of the Holy Spirit that we are bringing about Christ's kingdom.

Worthy to Be Blessed

Therefore, dearest brothers and sisters, if we want with our spiritual eyes to see Jesus ascending into heaven and if we want to arrive in heaven with him and through him, we ought to go forth in mind and in contemplation from this world. We ought also, if we can, to raise our hearts from the physical senses and take up the *bright weapons of obedience* [Rule of Benedict Prol. 3]. We ought not to set the reward of our obedience in the valleys—that is, in earthly and base things—nor on the hill of pride, lest the Lord say of us, *Amen, I tell you, they have received their reward* [Matt 6:2, 5]. But our obedience ought to be on the mountain of charity, so that whatever we do, we do for the love of God.


