Reflection

Capricious Love

Our two children often ask why we love them. My wife and I always answer, "because you're our children and every day we make the conscious decision to love you without measure." "That sounds capricious," my son said. He is right. As they grow older, they continue to ask the same question, at times with some skepticism. It is like they are awaiting the day when the answer will change.

Sometimes they don't make the best decisions or they fall short of their potential. As we discern those moments together, then they ask: "Do you still love me?" We say, "Yes!" Then they ask, "Why?" We respond, "Because you're our children and every day we make the conscious decision to love you without measure."

I appreciate their puzzled looks. It will take most of their lives to realize that they don't have to earn our love. We love them because they are our children and every day we make the conscious decision to love them without measure. All we do, all we give them, is a free expression of our love as parents.

How many times have we asked whether God actually loves us? What about wondering if God loves others who are not like us? We don't always accept that God's love for us is free and abundant. God gave us new life in Jesus and bestows the Holy Spirit freely because of love.

Here is one way to embrace Jesus' invitation to remain in his love: to know ourselves loved abundantly and capriciously as God's children. All else will follow from there.




